Why do we need coordination with other NCP networks?

- **The RI program is relevant to many scientific domains**
- **We share the same customers and the same research community**
- **Offering more research opportunities to our shared community**
- **Benefiting from the experience of other NCPs**

Efficiently utilize and manage organization knowledge

- **Each NCP develops knowledge and tools and share it with his NCP network**
- **Human efforts and money are invested to produce this knowledge and tools**
- **Unique knowledge in specific domains can be useful and productive to our network**
- **Efficient tools can be utilized with a minimal adaptation effort and cost**
